

## **Admission Procedure for UG and PG Courses**

Admission procedure is as per the rules and regulations of Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam. 50% of the seats of PG and UG courses are filled by the University through the Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) and the remaining seats by the management by candidates of its own choice by observing the eligibility conditions prescribed by the University. Out of the 50% merit seats, 65% of the seats will be filled on general merit and 35% will be filled from candidates belonging to SC, ST and other Backward communities in the order of merit. Admission/ Allotment of seats under merit quota is governed by a Centralized Allotment Process. Selection/ Allotment of a candidate to the college will be based on the rank of the candidate and the availability of seats. The prospectus on Centralized Allotment Process will be available in the CAP Portal:- **cap.mgu.ac.in**. There is only a single application form for applying for admission to the U.G. Degree Programmes in various affiliated colleges.

Com Taxation (40 Seats)</b>	Admission to the B.Com Degree Programmes shall be open only to candidates who have passed the Plus Two or equivalent examination recognized by this University with Book-Keeping and Accountancy and any two of the following subjects, viz., (1) Commerce (2) Commercial Correspondence and Commercial Geography (3) Economics (4) Life Insurance with Salesmanship (5) Banking with Secretarial Practice (6) Business Studies (7) Mathematics (8) Computer Science/ Computer applications (9) Informatics Practice& Management , (10) Informatics Practice , (11) Management, (12) Accountancy as optional under Part III of the Examination.OR Have passed Plus Two or equivalent examination recognized by this University with other subjects under Part III optional subjects provided they have secured 45% of the aggregate marks.	3 years (6 Semesters)
<b>4. B.Sc. Mathematics with Statistics and Computer Science as Complementary courses ( 60 Seats)</b>	Candidate shall be required to have passed +2 or equivalent examination with Mathematics as one of the optional subjects or Mathematics as one of the subjects in Commerce group.	3 years (6 Semesters)
<b>5. Bachelor of Business Administration (B.B.A) (60 Seats)</b>	Candidate shall be shall be required to have passed Plus Two or equivalent examination or an examination recognized as equivalent thereto by this University.	3 years (6 Semesters)
<b>6. Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) (40 Seats)</b>	Candidate shall be shall be required to have passed Plus Two or equivalent examination or an examination recognized as equivalent thereto by this University.	3 years (6 Semesters)
<b>7. B.A. English (Triple Main) ( 40 Seats)</b>	Candidate shall be required to have passed +2 or equivalent examination or an examination recognized by MG University as equivalent thereto.	3 years (6 Semesters)

<b>8. B. A. Economics ( Model II, Foreign Trade)</b>  (40 Seats)	Candidate shall be required to have passed +2 or equivalent examination or an examination recognised by MG University as equivalent thereto.	3 years  (6 Semesters)
<b>9. B. A. Hindi</b>  (24 Seats)	Candidate shall be required to have passed +2 or equivalent examination or an examination recognised by MG University as equivalent thereto.	3 years  (6 Semesters)
<b>10. B. A. Malayalam</b>  (40 Seats)	Candidate shall be required to have passed +2 or equivalent examination or an examination recognised by MG University as equivalent thereto.	3 years  (6 Semesters)
<b>11. Bachelor of Library and Information Science (B. LI. Sc.)</b>  (30 Seats)	Pass in any degree with not less than 45% marks. Candidates belonging to SC/ST category require only 40% of marks.	1 year  (2 Semesters)

Mathematics/ Computer Science/ Electronics/ IT under part III with not less than 50% marks or BCA with not less than 50% marks. OR B.Tech with not less than 50% marks in Mathematics (aggregate of all Mathematics papers and a total of 50% marks for the entire course).  Candidates having degree in Computer Science/ Computer Applications/ Electronics shall be given a weightage of 20% marks in qualifying degree examinations.	2 years  (4 semesters)

<b>4. M. A. Malayalam</b>  <b>(30 Seats)</b>	Graduation in Malayalam(B.A. Malayalam) with not less than CGPA of 1.8 out of 4 in the Core Group (Core + open + Complementary) OR Graduation in all faculties who have taken Malayalam under Common course -II (Four common papers) with not less than CGPA of 2.00 out of 4 and also secured CGPA of 1.8 out of 4 Core Group(Core + Open + Complementary)	2 years  (4 semesters)
<b>5. M. A. English</b>  <b>(30 Seats)</b>	Graduates in English under part III(Model I/II/III) and graduates in other faculties of language and literature, social science, science, Oriental studies are eligible for applying M.A. English Programme provided they satisfy the eligibility criteria as stipulated by the M.G. University.  Applicants should posses CGPA of 1.80 out of 4.00 in the core group(core + complementary + open course) in part III	2 years  (4 semesters)
<b>6. M. A. Economics</b>  <b>(20 Seats)</b>	Graduation in Economics /Mathematics / Statistics with not less than CGPA of 1.8 out of 4 in the core group (Core + Open + Complementary)	2 years  (4 semesters)
