PG and FYUGP Admissions

Admissions to undergraduate (U.G.) and postgraduate (P.G.) programs in colleges affiliated with Mahatma Gandhi University are conducted through the Centralized Allotment Process (CAP). The following steps outline the process:

1. Online Registration:
 - All students wishing to apply for admission must log in to the official M.G. University website (www.mgu.ac.in) and submit their applications online through the CAP portal(www.cap.mgu.ac.in)
2. Management Quota Admission:
 - Students seeking admission under the Management Quota must complete two key steps:
 - First, register online through the University CAP portal.
 - Then, submit a college-specific application form, which can be obtained from the respective college office or website.
 - The CAP registration printout must be attached with the college-specific application when submitting it to the college.
3. Important Instructions:
 - All required documents should be submitted within the deadline set by the college.
 - The application procedure for Management Quota may vary from one college to another, so students are advised to carefully follow the specific instructions provided by the respective colleges.

MA Economics	Graduation in Economics, Mathematics or Statistics with at least 1.80 CGPA/4.50 CCPA (45% marks) in Core Groups.
MCom Finance and Taxation	Graduation in Commerce /BBA/BBM with not less than CCPA of 4.0 out of 10 in the Core Group (Core + Complementary + Open Courses).
